This is the portrait of Colonel Charles-Louis-Prosper, 4th Marquis de Chérisey (1786-1837) at the time when he commanded the 38th line infantry regiment under the Restoration

The representation of the character's uniform can be dated to 1823, the date on which he became a Commander of the Order of the Legion of Honor. He wears the Military Order of Prussia, received in 1817. He was also a Knight of the Order of Saint Louis and a Knight of the Order of Saint Ferdinand of Spain, decorations that can be seen on his left lapel, in the shadows.
