The cymatium is a succession of rocailles scrolls and vegetal racemes, while on the sides two cherub heads stand out. The lower part has raceme motifs that contribute to the elegance and refinement of this splendid object. The mirror is made of mercury salt glass and is contemporary with the wooden frame.
