(TOL for Tolosa, the old name of the city).Height: 20.3 cm.TOULOUSE, first half of the 18th centuryIt should be noted that in Toulouse, like many French centers, the royal edict of 1691, the control mark was not strictly respected. This mark with the vintage of 1709 is the last listed, so it was used for a large part of the 18th century without being updated. In the absence of a master's mark, this control therefore does not allow us to precisely date the objects that
