decorative painter in the 1880s. He was responsible for the interior decoration of commercial establishments and private homes in Brussels¹. Among other things, in 1902 he created, with Adolphe Crespin, the decor of the Bibliothèque Solvay, wall decorations in the Max Hallet hotel built by Victor Horta and two painted canvases dated 1907, in a house at 256 Chaussée d'Haecht^{2,3}.

As he acquired expertise in ceiling decoration, he was invited to work in London and Blackpool to create ceiling decorations for theatres¹.
