Born in Lyon, son of a renowned architect, Jean François Charles André Flachéron, known as Count Frédéric Flachéron, entered the Royal School of Fine Arts in Paris in 1836. He stayed in Rome, and became a friend of Ingres. He became with Giacomo Caneva one of the main leaders of the circle of photographers of the Caffè Greco. He died on June 21, 1883 and is buried in the Montparnasse cemetery.
