Description

Very picturesque oil on canvas, representing the arrival of fishing boats in the old port of La Rochelle, signed lower left Roger Dubut. (1890-1960). The painter set up his easel at the bottom of the lantern tower: in the foreground, at the bottom of the chain tower, the unloading of fish with a crowd of people in the boats and on the quay; in the background the Saint Nicolas tower. Very colorful painting, with impressionist touches. Roger Dubut is a painter from Saint Laurent near Périgueux. Self-taught painter, he made a career in the army and fixed on canvas, during his travels, many landscapes. He was a member of the French Artists and the Fine Arts of Overseas, Berheim de Villers Prize in 1958. He was a generous artist who strove to bring to life colorful works, sometimes a little naive.
