Charge Hallmark of the Sous-Fermier for DIEPPE, Hallmarks (body and thumb rest) of Maison Commune for DIEPPE 1761-65 (P Couronné) and Hallmarks (large works) on body, and small works on thumb rest) of Master Goldsmith Pierre LE CANU received in 1763.
