The top face is guilloche, the perimeter is roughened, so as not to slip when handling. It weighs 170 grams. And measures 4.5 cm in diameter and 5 cm high. Excerpt: 19th century hospital heritage: Late 19th century scarifier with blades for suction cups: The invention of the scarifier dates back to the 17th century. All you have to do is press a trigger for this scarifier to simultaneously activate its blades and incise the skin. It was mainly used in combination with
