Bronze fittings, smooth cap, checkered iron underguard. Sloping walnut stock with finely checkered grip. Iron ramrod. Total length of the pistol 34 cm. France. Restoration - July Monarchy. Fairly good condition, oxidation on the metal parts, some wear on the stock.
