The painting in question depicts a nobleman dressed in a black robe, exemplifying his institutional position in the legal-notarial field. The gaze fixed on the outside observer to the painting and the pose in half-obscured three quarters identify the portrait as 'official', or commissioned by the nobleman for a private or public use, but through which the nobility of the effigy should shine.
