Salvador Dalí, born in Figueras on May 11, 1904, and died in the same city, on January 23, 1989, is a Catalan painter, sculptor, engraver, screenwriter and writer of Spanish nationality. He is considered one of the main representatives of surrealism, and one of the most famous painters of the 20th century. The work is an anamorphosis.
