huge Dutch herring fishing fleet and Holland's numerous commercial ships generated so much money that it had to come to a conflict with that other power at sea, the British, during the third quarter of the 17th century. Verbeeck takes an important place among the early Dutch marine painters, following closely its first generation (Hendrick Vroom, Cornelis van Wieringen, Aert Anthonisz., Jan Porcellis, Abraham de Verwer and Adam Willaerts).
