Large portrait of a woman with a parrot after Abraham Janssens II "The Allegory of Touch". The parrot bites her until she bleeds, a very rare scene that can be found in the painting "The Lady with the Parrot" presented at the Museum of Fine Arts in Lille, by an anonymous author. In painting, the parrot is a symbol of purity and innocence. It can also be represented as an exotic animal, it then becomes, due to its rarity and price, an indicator of social status. Flemish school from the beginning of the 17th century.
