Brass Reliquary (ex Ossibus) Containing the Relics of 12 Saints + Episcopal Document (Coa) Very fine 19th-century brass reliquary containing twelve first-class relics (os - ex ossibus) with its episcopal wax seal and intact threads, accompanied by its document of authenticity signed on February 13, 1877, from the Diocese of Andreas Ignatius Schaepman, Archbishop of Utrecht from 1868 to 1882. Description 19th-century brass reliquary preciously containing the relics under glass of 12 saints: Saints Candia, Saints Valentini, Saints Joan Berg, Saints Guisberti, Saints Vincenti, Saints Antoniae, Saints Alaysii Conz, Saints Juliae, Saints Govo M, Saint Ursulae, St. Francis Sal, St. Petri Carer. The relics, with their Latin names, are placed on a golden yellow silk
