



Base In The Shape Of A Winged Lion In Stone



Description

"This is a fragment of a sculpture depicting a winged lion, carved from Verona stone and probably dating back to the 1500s. The lion, a symbol of strength and royalty, has a powerful appearance, with a mane carefully sculpted around its face. The wings, extending symmetrically to the sides, indicate a connection to the symbolic iconographies of the Renaissance, where winged lions often represented power and dominion. In the lower section, floral decorations in relief can be seen, along with a base adorned with geometric and curvilinear patterns. Time has left marks of wear on the surface, revealing some erosion, but the sculpture still retains its solemnity and artistic detail."
