Description 19th century silver reliquary preciously containing a relic of Saint Paul of the Cross. The relic with its name in Latin is soberly placed on a red fabric background. The back of the reliquary opens to reveal the red wax seal and its red silk threads guaranteeing its authenticity. About Saint Paul of the Cross, born in 1694 and died in 1775 in Rome in the Papal States, was an Italian priest, mystic
