The Alhambra, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is a masterpiece of Nasrid art and architecture, embodying the pinnacle of Andalusian Islamic craftsmanship and cultural heritage. The oratory, which is part of this model, includes an inscription attributed to Yusuf I (reigned 1333-1354). Recent studies, including dendrochronological analysis of the original oratory's wooden elements, confirm that its construction was completed during the reign of Yusuf I, although initiated by Ismail I (reigned 1314-1325).
