Rear arms as it should be link the two pieces the beautiful pediment (his) with plume motif which in its upper part is decorated with flowers and acanthus leaves falling on each side of flowers and stylized basket and scrolls and crosspieces, tops the beautiful frame of the original mercury tin which is not without merit.
