Pendulum floor lamp. Gilded brass tripod base from which rises a wooden shaft housing an articulated arm finished with a counterweight, also in gilded brass. This arm supports a large reflector. Recent lampshade, identical to the original. Lampshade and bulb holder in metal, lacquered black on the outside and white on the inside, with gilded brass ball joint and handle. Maximum height: 175 cm (68.9 inches - 5.74 feet)
