The exceptional dining tables, chairs and dressers are made of woven wicker, rattan and other natural fibers more commonly found in casual outdoor rooms. During its heyday in the mid-20th century, Italian designer Flam Sansoni created most of the company's furniture. In the early 1980s, Vera dining chairs were used by the Les Arcs ski resort in Savoie, France. They were personally selected by influential French designer and architect Charlotte Perriand. The company's high-quality pieces are still highly sought after by collectors.
