Description

Wind gust before the chapel of Saint Sixtus in Provence. Oil on canvas signed Jean Del Devez, French painter of the early 20th century. He was a member of the outsider art school, a term invented by the English art critic Roger Cardinal as a synonym for art brut, which is a term created by the French artist Jean Dubuffet. He was a member of the independent painters of the Butte Montmartre, an informal group of artists in Paris. was notably featured in the major exhibition "Les Singuliers de l'Art" at the Musée d'Art Moderne de la Ville de Paris from January 19 to March 5, 1978.
