The painting is perfectly highlighted by its original Montparnasse frame in carved and patinated wood. Signed lower right. Located on the back of the canvas. Dimensions: 54 cm x 73 cm (20 P format) 72 cm x 91 cm with its frame Good condition. Never touched, a light cleaning could therefore be considered.
