Max LE VERRIER (1891-1973): French sculptor of ancient Greco-Egyptian inspiration known for his Art Deco works. After a career as a military pilot, he developed a passion for art and resumed his studies at the École des Beaux-Arts in Geneva. Back in Paris in 1919, he took up sculpture and became famous for his bronze works (with his own mix of metals), notably animal sculptures. Gold medal at the 1925 International Exhibition of Decorative Arts.
