Attributable to the HB Grande Maison factory in Quimper. Polychrome earthenware, circa 1890. Height 7 cm, width 5.5 cm.

The difference between a snuff box and a tobacco shaker? The snuff box is generally a box with a lid allowing access to the grip by pinching strands of tobacco. The shaker is a closed container. The tobacco comes out through an orifice by shaking the object towards the palm of the hand, between the thumb and index finger.
