Mahogany sideboard chest of drawers opening with 2 doors revealing three drawers with low fronts and 2 long drawers in the belt underlined by a net finished with palmettes and the other in plinth top in gray marble Sainte Anne Stamped twice Lemarchand Louis Édouard Lemarchand born in 1795 was a soldier in the imperial armies and in 1815 he returned to his father's workshop The cabinetmaker Charles Joseph Lemarchand 1759 - 1826 at 17 rue des tournelles which he took over the management of upon his death he developed it and received the title of cabinetmaker of the furniture of the Crown and Duke of Orleans under the reign of Louis Philippe delivering for all the royal palaces missing the key and a baguette to the top drawer jump of veneers on the plinth lower part visible
