Important bronze proof with brown patina, representing a "Gaul Hunter" accompanied by his dog, by the sculptor Marcel Debut (1865-1933) .The hunter is standing, bare-chested, dressed only in a skin held by a harness, he is armed with his spear and an axe .The power and virility of Man are highlighted here .The dog, for its part, is standing still, looking towards the horizon on the lookout for prey, its senses are alert .Signature of the sculptor "MARCEL DEBUT" in hollow, on the side of the naturalist terrace. Rare old edition sculpture, late 19th century period .Perfect state of conservation and patina .Height : 81 cmMarcel Debut (1865-1933) Marcel Debut is a famous French sculptor and painter, born in Paris on March 27, 1865. Mr. Debut began his apprenticeship with his father, the sculptor Jean

Didier Debut (1824-1893) .He then followed the teaching of sculptors Jules Lefebvre (1834-1912) and Pierre François Marie Boulanger (1813-1891) .He exhibited at the French artists fair, of which he was a member, from 1883 and obtained an Honorable Mention in 1895 .Marcel Debut is considered one of the most important academic sculptors operating in France between the 19th and 20th centuries .Between classicism and explicit realism, he found an original path.
