



## Restoration Period Alarm Clock In Perfect Condition.



## Description

Alarm clock from the time of Charles X, completely revised and polished. To wind the movement, a square section key fits into the front below the dial and to wind the alarm bell, a ring is connected by a string made of natural material and is pulled to wind the bell which will be used to make a hammer strike the bell. The alarm time is set using a hand on the dial. (To the nearest 10 minutes.)

The advance or delay is adjusted at the top of the dial using a small needle that you move with your finger.
