Magnificent work "edited and lithographed by Auguste Bassy in Pau" and "printed by Lemercier in Paris" of which there are very few copies, with several prints and different combinations of plates. All the plates in this collection are signed by Eugène Devéria (1805 - 1865), designer and painter. Bears two ex-libris stamps under the title of "Js Liebach Hartmann in Mulhouse": Jacques HARTMANN-LIEBACH (1794-1876), industrialist and owner of the Hartmann Liebach spinning mill located on rue des Champs in Mulhouse.
