HPR stamped Henri Picard & Raingo The bronzes are stamped and founder of the famous Parisian gilder Henri Picard, who provided the "little Louvre apartments" for the Emperor Napoleon III and was known for the high quality of its production. The company Raingo Brothers was founded in 1813 and works for the Duke of Chartres in 1823. In 1841, the watch business in addition to the art and bronze furnishings. Headquartered at 102 rue Vieille du Temple in 1860, this house, provider of the Emperor and Empress, has a large bronzes exhibition store. Mould to ove reasons are many, the spandrels "old head" doors are really impressive. In the middle doors figure "Demeter"

the goddess of fertility and another Greek God probably the God of volcanoes "Hephaestus" The sides have 4 large spandrels in reminder to those present on the doors and a large central bouquet center. The top black marble embedded in the shelf with recess, this marble to many snail inlay (and a small restored corner). The shelf corners are trimmed in perforated bronzes. On the lower deck, we find embedded ingot, squares with acanthus leaves and a beautiful shell. The cabinet has its original key and high double-latch lock. The inside of the doors is decorated frame beads nets. 2 brass-rays. It should be noted that its small size is unusual and exceptional quality bronzes dimensions: Width: 110 Depth: 43 Height: 93.5
