



Annunciation From The Early 1700s - Papal State, Ancient Frame



Description

Interesting painting executed with remarkable pictorial qualities and depicting "Annunciation". This is a work that fits into the sphere of the craftsmen active in the Papal State at the end of the 17th century, who took their cue from the schools of the great Roman masters, Andrea Sacchi, Pietro da Cortona, Carlo Maratta, etc.

The painting is in first canvas and never restored and has a frame from the early 1700s in black lacquer and gold, as is the painting executed in the first quarter of the century.

The canvas measures 64×49 cm, with the frame measures 77×62 cm.
