"Cherreada", illustrated by Jean de Fougerolles and published in 1990, is the Mexican rodeo that is practiced in an arena called Lienzo. The men confront the bull, show their prowess with the lasso, and train the horses. The women ride the horses side-saddle, and show their dexterity by stopping their mounts abruptly as they gallop. This silk twill scarf with hand-rolled edges finds its title centered at the top, the name of the Hermès house centered at the bottom. The copyright is located at the top left, while the illustrator's signature is found at the bottom right. Beautiful original condition, conservation and use, no holes, no stains, no discoloration.
