## Description

Rare and opulent sloping desk called donkey's back in stained cherry wood from the mid-18th century in Louis XV style. This desk was that of a very rich provincial Matayer, opulent and well-carved, this robust piece of furniture and accompanied by its magnificent bronze boingnées, keyholes, camped on solid arched "snail" feet and with a moving front and crosspiece, paneled sides, theater furnished with drawers and a trap door for a "false secret". The flap driven by arms in large wrought iron is solid and its very thick walnut herringbone face ensures real writing comfort through its generosity. This piece of furniture alone, well preserved, untouched, was by the choice of a cherry heart loaded with tannin (which prevents worms and others), a technique that the Ancients
