Description

Ball-shaped ring in 750/°° yellow gold (18 KT, eagle's head hallmark), richly decorated and worked on the contrast of colors and materials....It offers a characteristic combination of jewelry by associating two of the most precious stones, in so-called "colored" stones, here the ruby, and the brilliant-cut diamond in paving. The closed-set rubies are evenly distributed over this large volume. Each of them is surrounded by a line of grain-set diamonds contributing to the brilliance of the ring. The design formed by the diamonds thus emphasizing the oval shape of the rubies creates a scalloped effect on the profile of the jewel. The rubies offer a beautiful sustained color and their specific gemmological phenomena are only visible by transparency on the photos, but not when worn on

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the finger. Their crystallization, also difficult to reproduce in a photo, is lively. These beautiful materials are set on a carefully designed setting, soft to the touch and to wear. Total weight of rubies estimated at approximately 4.50 carats
Total weight of diamonds estimated at approximately 1.20 carats Gross weight: 20.47 g
Ring size: 55 to the measurement - possible resizing to be studied by our workshop (current diameter 1.73 cm / US size 7.5) Condition: imperceptible micro-scratches on the body of the ring, characteristic natural inclusions in the rubies not visible when worn, natural inclusions in the diamonds not visible to the naked eye.
