In Balinese folklore, Rangda is a powerful and terrifying witch queen who leads an army of demonic spirits known as Leyaks. Celuluk, one of her loyal minions, is often portrayed with bulging eyes, sharp fangs, and a grotesque grin, symbolizing chaos, transformation, and supernatural power. These masks are used in sacred dance dramas, such as the Barong dance, which represents the eternal battle between good (Barong, the protective spirit) and evil (Rangda and her demons). Celuluk
