This elegant model is decorated with a rich relief decoration, superbly chiseled acanthus leaves, flower buds, festoon pearls and leafy fillets on the edge of the spatulas finished with a very beautiful volute return at their ends. Of remarkable density, these twenty-four pieces are in excellent condition (micro-scratches from usual use, two or three interiors of spoons paler than the others, as for the vermeil, in no way affecting the harmony of the whole.
