H 8.5 cm x W 6 cm x D 3 cm According to Hindu scriptures, Devi Lakshmi adopted Lord Ganesha from her mother, Parvati, declaring that all her wealth and prosperity belonged to her. This relationship underlines the importance of honoring both deities; it is said that one cannot achieve true prosperity without simultaneously worshipping Lakshmi and Ganesha.
