## Description

This pressed glass bowl, designed by Pierre D'Avesn around 1930, perfectly embodies the spirit of Art Deco thanks to its stylized floral motifs and finely worked relief. The surface, decorated with three large flowers whose petals capture and refract the light, gives the whole a unique and sophisticated shine. The glass, with shades ranging from translucent to a slightly satiny tone, testifies to the exceptional know-how of the artist, who trained with René Lalique.
