The painting on the left:

The scene is animated by human and animal figures, including shepherds with their livestock, immersed in rural life.

Right painting:

It presents a landscape with a large natural rock arch, crossed by a small river or stream. There are human and animal figures, who appear to be engaged in daily activities. The softer lighting and the sky with blue-gold tones evoke a feeling of peace and harmony with nature.

Artistic features:
