- Folded polychrome silk fan from the Duvelleroy house in Paris with its original box representing a decor of a gallant scene in a park with two medallions on either side of the gallant scene painted in gouache enhanced with gold and silver glitter with gold-colored thread. - Decoration of a flowering branch painted in gouache on the silk on the other side of the fan. - Pierced ivory frame painted in gold and silver and reference number on an ivory stem of the fan and in Indian ink on the box. - Original box with the label stuck on the box from the Duvelleroy house. - Foxing spots inside the box and corner of the box torn on the two corners of the top of the box. - Period end of the 19th century around 1880-1895.
