Maybe: it is suggested to me that the angular position of the head would be due to the rigor mortis and due to the torture... and that if we position the lead recumbent figure vertically, and at a height, it always keeps watch... I will let you be the judge. Ancient object without age because I cannot find a stylistic reference.
