Good condition, very shiny, but uneven and rather short tines, see photos.Bordeaux 1743 charge mark and almost illegible discharge mark. Community mark: "BOR L" Bordeaux 1742/43.Master silversmith mark: Pierre Rivière (younger brother) born in 1696, received master in Bordeaux on April 27, 1718.Period monogram: "IP" on each spatula.Length: 18.5 cm.Total weight: 167 g.Collection possible without delivery costs at our shop in Bordeaux, 59 rue Huguerie, contact us.
