Albert Gleizes, at the request of the publisher Jacques Klein, undertook a two-year work to illustrate Pascal's Pensées. He gave the keys to understanding it in his introduction to the exhibition catalogue when the work was released in Saint-Etienne in 1951 under the title "Why I
