Ghurra are traditional elements of the daily life of the mountain populations of Nepal, used to stabilize and guide the pole used for churning milk into butter. Carved from wood, they combine functionality and aesthetics, each piece being unique and often decorated with symbolic motifs.

Our example is distinguished by the finesse of its sculptures representing animal motifs, testimony to local artisanal know-how.

Its patina of use, resulting from its use, gives the object a lot of charm.
