In a beautiful rectangular format that presents it well in a gilded frame with carved wooden ear, this remarkable oil on canvas is a "Flight from Egypt," of quality and beautiful composition, Flanders 1670. Joseph marking with a resolute step, bare feet, bust leaning forward, the path and leaving with Mary from their cave with lush vegetation and heading towards the light of a vast clearing where an enigmatic statue of a colossus leaning its head standing on its cracked pedestal base. Mary seated facing us on a donkey is wearing a hat and protects her child with her delicately entwined arms, she is dressed in a large dark blue outfit, while Joseph is in a brown linen toga with bare calves, the donkey is very expressive in the effort with piercing eyes. The rich palette of this beautiful work of careful
