Description

This clock is a superb example of neoclassical elegance, inspired by the opulent style of the Empire period. The timepiece fits perfectly into the rounded body of the vase, framed by a finely guilloché border with delicate patterns. The dial, featuring Roman numerals on a white enamel section, adds a touch of classical sophistication, contrasting beautifully with the gilded hands and ornaments. One of its most striking decorative elements is the pair of swan-neck handles that curve gracefully upwards, recalling the elegant motifs characteristic of the French Empire style. At the top of the clock is a cherub figure, adding a romantic and mythological dimension to the design. The base is
