It is a large crown of laurel leaves and plants held at the top by a Louis XVI knot, with its ribbons hanging on the sides.

the whole forms a tondo frame or a bull's eye.

it is a very beautiful framing element in very thick and very heavy solid marble with a thick bronze reed set in the mass.

small restoration on one of the ribbons.

be careful this piece of sculpted marble is very heavy.

a superb marble Louis XVI style decoration.
