Gaston THIERY landscape painter, considered the continuator of the Crozant school, will see his works distributed in Europe, Japan, the United States and are today part of many public and private collections. He exhibited his landscape and nature painting in the largest Parisian

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galleries. From 1965, solicited by Paul ANDRAUD, master weaver in Aubusson, he made his first tapestry cartoons. This adventure would last 30 years and would see the creation of more than 100 cartoons. An accomplished artist, invested in the life of his village, he left his mark on the Creuse valley from 1940 to 2013.
