Condition report: freshness of the gilding, woodworm holes, part of the frame is missing

This virgin, represented in profile, is wearing a shroud. The background is matted and highlighted with branches. The flesh tone is still partially present as is the color of the hair. The gilding is cleaned and still very present. By the presence of grooves on the sides, this suggests a tongue surround typical of 17th century
