The case is in blackened wood and a delightful marquetry depicting scrolls in brass threads and mother-of-pearl flowers. Rosewood-veneered interior. The cabaret is removable. Original glassware, just one glass very slightly different. The carafes need cleaning because of deposits inside. The key and lock work, slight lack of wood taken up at the level of the lock entry. Napoleon III period around 1870-1880. Delivery by carrier, 50 euros in France, 150 euros in the EU and 500 euros rest of the world.
