Vintage silver print with sepia toning signed circa 1905 Tunisian, oriental beauty at the window. Monogram "Lenhert and Landrock Tunis" and wet stamp of the photographers on the back. Lenhert & Landrock experimented with many photographic processes: heliogravure, gelatin-bromide printing, gum bichromate, sepia or platinum toning. - Under 40x50cm mat - Photo format 16.5x 22 cm - Sheet format 18 x 24 cm The photographer Rudolf LENHERT (1878-1948) and his partner Ernst LANDROCK are at the origin of the most important photography studio in the Mediterranean basin at the beginning of the 20th century. Heir to the orientalist wave of the 19th century, LENHERT discovered the Orient in the 1900s and joined forces in 1904 with LANDROCK, a manager
